



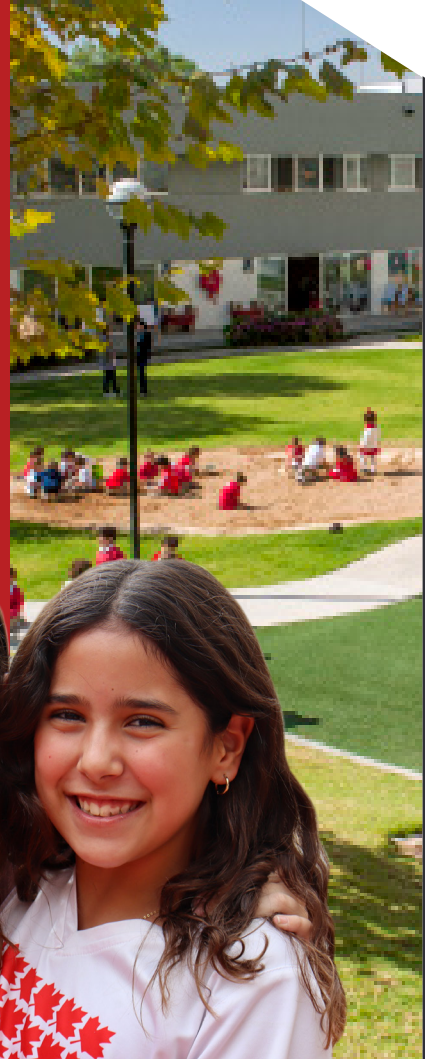

Canadian School® offers a comprehensive program of academic experiences abroad, in collaboration with various school districts and boarding schools in Canada.

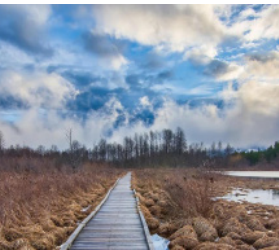

ADMISSION PROCESS



1. To pay the admission evaluation fee at the school's cashier.
2. Once the evaluation fee is paid, to bring the following documents:

- Copies of parents' ID.
- Current job recommendation letter (if you own your business, the letter can be written by a partner, accountant, or administrator).
- Passport-sized photos (with names on the back of each).
- Copy of the latest SEP (Secretariat of Public Education) report card.
- No debt certificate.
- Confidential teacher's report on the student's profile.
- Online admission application.
- Letter of recommendation from Canadian School family (if you know one).

3. To attend a required interview (both parents).
4. To take the admission evaluation (date and time will be communicated via email).
5. Admission process results will be communicated via email.
6. If admitted, you must submit the following documents on your appointment day:

- Copy of birth certificate.
- Printed CURP (Unique Population Registry Code).
- Vaccination card copy.
- Early Years certificate (G1-G7).
- Elementary school certificate (G7).
- Copy of current SGMM (Medical Insurance).
- Copy of FM3 (for foreign students).
- Junior High certificate (G10-G12).
- Copy of SEP report cards (SK-G12).

7. To pay the enrollment fee.
